As the HPP continues to look forward, one of the most important steps is to provide better support for our national athletes at major international competitions, and therefore we are looking to fill following roles:


Team Coach - World University Orienteering Championships Team

As orienteering is a late specialization sport, support and opportunities for young seniors is critical to helping them make the jump from junior to senior ranks. Therefore, the High Performance Committee wants to place a greater emphasis on the WUOC. Ideally, the Team Coach would be able to work with the athletes throughout the training season, in the buildup to the event, and provide support at the event itself. The level of financial assistance is currently being discussed.

As the HPP grows and our international results improve, the HPC sees the need to establish an official Administration Team. The members of the Admin Team will play a critical role in our support network, and will be an integral part of the High Performance Program.
