



Contract Job Opportunity for an Experienced Orienteer

Part-time, finishing by July 31, 2012

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECT COORDINATOR

Goal: To collect and organize existing material relating to junior training. This is the first phase of the creation of a national junior program curriculum.

COF has a high priority goal of creating a national junior program curriculum for junior orienteers and their coaches across Canada. There are many organizations and individuals who have created documents about training and coaching junior orienteers. The COF, with the help of the Sass Peepre Committee, wishes to collect and organize this material with the longer-term goal of using it to create a national junior program curriculum.

This job will involve:

- Contacting existing coaches, clubs, and junior programs across Canada about sharing information/documents;
- Collecting orienteering coaching and training tips, including exercises appropriate for juniors up to age 20, ranging from beginner to advanced;
- Consolidating, standardizing, and collating the collected material;
- Communicating regularly (weekly to start) with the Sass Peepre Committee to discuss progress, concerns and any modifications recommended;
- Working independently and using personal computer and internet connection.

Timeline: The deadline for project completion will be end of July 2012, in order to have the collection available for discussion at the COF Conference in August. Subsequent work related to this project may become available as the project evolves.

Contract wages: \$20 per hour to a maximum of \$1,000. Reasonable pre-approved expenses will be reimbursed.
