



Contract Job Opportunity for an Experienced Orienteer


Part-time for 4 months starting May 2012

SASS PEEPRE ONLINE TRAINING COORDINATOR

Goal: To coordinate a series of cross-Canada online training sessions as a pilot project.

The Sass Peepre Committee has a high priority goal of creating an online training program for junior orienteers across Canada. The target group would be juniors between the ages of 13 and 20 who are not currently in the COF's High Performance Program, especially those who do not have a club junior orienteering program available to them. Since this is a pilot project, the goal would be to have 5 to 10 participants. The online training sessions would occur bi-weekly, and would include discussions, presentations, map analysis sessions, etc. Initial preparation and set-up would occur before the first session.

- The time commitment for the coordinator will be approximately 40 hours for preparation and set-up in advance of the first session, plus 4 hours every two weeks during the approximately 16 weeks of the pilot project.
- The coordinator will recruit participants, schedule the online meetings, arrange for guest coaches, organize the topics and curriculum, prepare and distribute any documents needed for the online sessions, and ensure that the meetings run smoothly.
- The number of participants involved will be between 5 and 10, targeting juniors not currently in the High Performance Program, especially those who do not have a club junior program available to them.
- Online training sessions will occur every two weeks, once preparation is complete.
- Guest coaches will be invited to lead specific sessions to work with juniors.
- The coordinator will communicate with the Sass Peepre Committee to discuss progress:
 - Weekly while developing the program;
 - Regularly (at least monthly), once the training sessions begin; and
 - At the end of the 4 month program as a debriefing session.

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- The coordinator must be able to work independently and have use of their own computer, internet connection and Skype.

Timeline: The pilot project will run for 4 months starting in May 2012. The project may continue once the pilot project has been completed. Funding and the role of coordinator will be discussed at that time.

Contract wages: \$20 per hour to a maximum budget of \$1,500. Reasonable pre-approved expenses will be reimbursed.
