Articles of Continuance (transition)

8 The classes, or regional or other groups, of members that the corporation is authorized to establish

The Corporation is authorized to establish two classes of members known as Member Associations and National Senior and Junior Team Member Delegate. Each Member Association will be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members. Each National Senior and Junior Team Member Delegate will be entitled to receive notice of, attend but no vote at all meetings of the members, unless required by the Act.

9 Statement regarding the distribution of property remaining on liquidation

Any property remaining on liquidation of the Corporation, after discharge of liabilities, shall be distributed to one or more qualified donees within the meaning of subsection 248(1) of the Income Tax Act.

10 Additional provisions, if any

The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.

Directors shall serve without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his or her position as such, provided that a director may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in performing his or her duties. A director shall not be prohibited from receiving compensation for services provided to the corporation in another capacity.

Statement of the purpose of the corporation

- a) To promote orienteering in Canada; To encourage the formation of orienteering clubs throughout Canada and to further their interests; To render all possible services and assistance through the Corporation for the development and extension of orienteering;
- b) To secure as members the greatest possible number of reputable Canadian orienteering clubs;
- c) To establish and standardize the rules governing orienteering competitions and the classification of competitors;
- d) To hold annually a national orienteering competition at such place as may be selected by the Corporation;
- e) To arrange for the selection of competitors to represent Canada in international orienteering competitions;
- f) To provide, upon request, for the arbitration of such differences as may from time to time arise between clubs holding membership in the Corporation;
- g) To maintain a bureau of information regarding orienteering activities in Canada.
