On-going Development

After the successful evaluation pilot, we were given permission to proceed with the development of materials for the Comp-Intro workshop. This includes:

- The Analyze Performance module
- A section of Supporting the Competitive Experience that is orienteering specific
- A section of Teaching and Learning that is orienteering specific

Louise Oram has been contracted to work on the Analyze Performance material which encompasses all the technical skills needed to work with athletes at this level.

We have funding for the next fiscal year from the CAC to cover the development costs.

Other Activities

Orienteering Canada was represented at both the NSO day and Partners day with 60 other sports hosted by the Coaching Association of Canada.

Orienteering Canada also participates regularly in webinars and NSO calls hosted by CAC.
