Orienteering Canada ended the 2015/2016 year with an \$8,492 deficit on total revenue of \$158,161.

Revenue increased \$39,256 over the previous year. This was primarily due to mapping expense reimbursement. Donations for the year were \$9,039 (\$7,099 general and \$1,940 for HPP).

Expenses increased \$43,620 from the previous year. This was largely due to the mapping expenses.

Orienteering Canada has \$70,000 in term deposits and cash assets of \$21,068. Of this \$9,909 is allocated for the Sass Peepre fund.
