Sass Peepre Fund Committee
Terms of Reference

March 2010

Membership:

1. Members of the committee shall be appointed by the COF Board as needed.
2. The committee shall consist of a minimum of 3 people, whenever possible.
3. Committee members shall, wherever possible:
 - a) represent different regions of Canada;
 - b) represent different age classes;
 - c) have some connection to, and/or knowledge of, junior orienteering programs in their region;
 - d) be willing to support (as organizer, mentor, coach, manager or other) activities sponsored by the Fund.
4. One member of the committee shall be the main contact with the COF Board.
5. Committee members shall meet/communicate as needed.
6. The committee shall make recommendations to the COF Board for the purpose of administering the Sass Peepre Fund according to the objectives as outlined below.

Objectives:

1. The objectives of the committee shall be determined by its members and approved by the COF Board.
2. Objectives include:
 - a) to continue to support junior orienteering in Canada;
 - b) to foster leadership skills among junior orienteers;
 - c) to produce competent, life-long orienteers by teaching navigation skills and promoting friendships;
 - d) to benefit the greatest number of junior orienteers possible.
3. Priority shall be given to ensuring that at least one national junior training camp takes place in Canada annually. Every effort shall be made to have a national junior training camp in conjunction with each Canadian Championship.

Accountability:

1. The Committee shall report to the COF Board at least once per year.
2. The Committee shall report to the COF AGM annually.
