



Levies

The current COF Orienteering Rules state:

11.7.1 Levies for Canadian and North American Championships shall be forwarded to the Canadian Orienteering Federation within 30 days of the competition, accompanied by a copy of the start list.

- a) COC levies are 25% of registration fees, including late fees.
- b) COC related events, held within one week prior to or following the COC, NAOC or other major events sanctioned by COF and within such distance as to benefit from the major events, are subject to a COF levy of 25% of the event registration fee.

Notes:

1. Entry fees include all event entry fees and late fees for all competitors for all events taking place with the period 1 week before to one week after the events.
2. Levies are payable on the event fees from all classes of entry (including recreational, wayfaring groups, open classes and competitive classes).
3. There is no deduction for credit card charges or other registration system fees.
4. Levy does not apply to non event fees (like banquets, t-shirt sales or transportation).
5. Where there is a package price that includes non event fees then use a reasonable breakdown of the amount to allocate the package price to event fees and non event fees.
6. Exceptions for fund raising events (with the proceeds going to the High Performance Program, Sass Peepre or other COF program areas) are determined on a case by case basis.
