IOF Controlling System

- All events, for which the IOF competition rules are binding, shall be controlled by an **IOF Event Adviser**
- IOF now has 212 licensed Event Advisers (EA) including 45 Senior Event Adviser (SEA)
- IOF is appointing the IOF EA itself for WOC, WC , WG, JWOC, WMOC
- The Federation of the organiser (WOC, WC, JWOC, WMOC) shall always appoint a **national controller**
- If the IOF does not appoint an EA for the event in question, the controller appointed by the federation will be the IOF adviser
- All IOF EA shall hold the IOF event adviser's licence
- No IOF EA or IOF EA's assistant may have any responsibility for a participating team/athlete

The IOF Event Adviser (1/3)

- If the IOF adviser is appointed by the IOF, he or she is the official representative of the IOF to the organiser, is subordinate to the IOF Council and communicates via FOC or the IOF Secretariat.
- The federation of the organiser shall always appoint a national adviser. This adviser shall assist the EA appointed by the IOF
 - Typical responsibility sharing
 - IOF EA is taking care of the out-of-forest business
 - National adviser is taking care of the in-forest business
 - National adviser is participating at regular organizer meetings
- The IOF EA shall work in close collaboration with the organiser, and shall be given all relevant information

The IOF Event adviser (2/3)

- RC is responsible for the event advising “profession”
 - Basic training, introduction clinics
 - Maintaining the best level of knowledge and expertise among experienced EAs; EA seminars, newsletters
- RC is responsible to maintain and update the event advisers list, monitoring qualifications and experience
- Event advisers are appointed by FOC
- EAs relate to FOC on matters concerning their events
- FOC manages the event advising budget of its events
- FOC must ensure that the organisation of events follows IOF regulations and it must find solutions when problems occur

The IOF Event adviser (3/3)

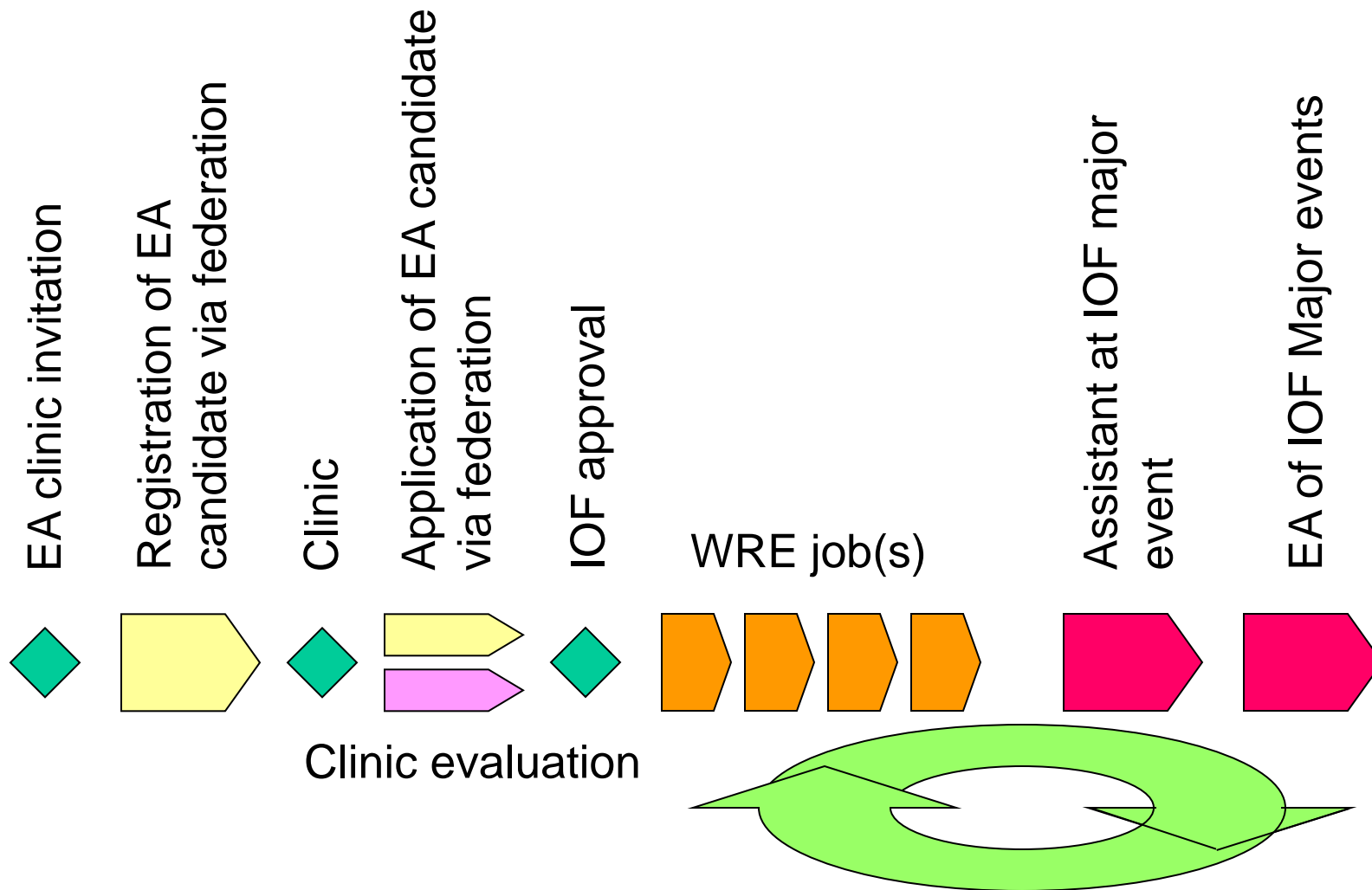
- All official information sent to the Federations or published on the Internet, such as bulletins or invitations, shall be approved by the EA
- The EA shall make as many controlling visits as he or she deems necessary
 - The visits shall be planned in agreement with the appointing authority and the organiser
- Immediately after each visit, the EA shall send a brief, written report to the IOF adviser appointing body with a copy to the organiser
- One or more assistants may be appointed to help the EA adviser
 - Mapping, courses, financing, sponsoring, media, etc

Empowerment Of IOF Event adviser

IOF Competition Rule 31.6

The IOF adviser has the authority to require adjustments to be made if he or she deems them necessary to satisfy the requirements of the event
