Past Year's Work

Over the past year the Major Events Committee has continued to support the 2019 and 2020 COC hosts with their planning for the Canadian Championships and is working with hosts to develop plans for the 2021 COCs. We have also been looking for hosts for the 2022 COCs and NAOCs, so far without success (please let us know at majorevents@orienteering.ca if you might be interested).

We have been continuing to develop and share material, knowledge, and best practices with event organizers.

We have also been working on overhauling the sanctioning procedure for COCs and NAOCs to be a more collaborative process between Orienteering Canada and local organizing committees.

Finally, we have been playing a part in the Canada Cup Working Group which is looking at making changes to Canada Cup sanctioning, branding, marketing, and more. This working group is ongoing.

Future Work - Projects and Goals

One of the major unresolved tasks which we are continuing to work on is recruiting one or more hosts for the 2022 COCs and NAOCs. We will also be looking for hosts for the 2023 COCs in the fall.

Continuing with the development of and sharing of material, knowledge, and best practices with event organizers is also an ongoing priority.

We have been quite successful with having regular monthly meetings through the fall and winter and checking in on the upcoming COCs in various stages of planning and making sure things are on track with those. When spring orienteering began regular meetings have taken a back seat. Finding time during the spring and summer months has been a challenge.
