### The Past Year

Only a limited number of workshops were delivered (all in Alberta) when there was a break in the shutdowns during 2020.

Following the trend for distance learning to circumvent the COVID restrictions, we developed an on-line module for the classroom activities of the Community Coach workshop using a self-guided format with an application called Talent LMS. It takes the students approximately 2.5 hours to complete the course and it is generally completed within 2 weeks of the second part of the workshop.

The second part of the workshop covers the outdoor practice activities and reviews of the on-line content. This two-part format has facilitated the scheduling of the outdoor activities by reducing the duration of that session to about 4 hours.

At this time about 30 new coaches have completed the on-line module.

### Looking Forward

We expect to complete the translation of the on-line module and the Facilitator's Guide early this summer so we can extend the delivery of the workshop to our new French-speaking coaches.

We are looking forward to a busy coach training schedule as soon as the distancing restrictions are relaxed.
