**Terms of Reference
Special Committee - Ongoing**

Committee Purpose

The Celebration, Awards and Recognition Committee recognizes, honours and pays tribute to outstanding athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers in Canadian orienteering. The committee also creates and implements plans to celebrate milestones in Canadian orienteering, and researches and nominates orienteers for various award opportunities.

Committee Membership

- The Celebration, Awards and Recognition Committee has three to six members appointed by the Board of Directors from the Orienteering Canada membership.

Scope of Responsibility

The Celebration, Awards and Recognition Committee is responsible for:

- developing and implementing programming and nomination processes to recognize outstanding athletes, officials, coaches and other volunteers within the Canadian orienteering community;
- identifying award programs (outside of Orienteering Canada) in which outstanding orienteers (athlete, coach, officials and other volunteers) are potential candidates.
- ensure that strong candidates are nominated for appropriate awards (Orienteering Canada award programs and external award programs), and recognize and celebrate recipients of awards;
- developing and implementing plans to celebrate significant milestones in Canadian orienteering (for instance, Orienteering Canada's 50th anniversary in 2017);
- liaising with other committees as required;
- liaising with the member clubs and provincial / territorial associations regarding celebration, awards and recognition programs.
