Terms of Reference

Special Committee - Ongoing

Committee Purpose

The Ski Orienteering Committee leads and manages the programs of Orienteering Canada that exist to promote and grow Ski Orienteering opportunities and initiatives.

Committee Membership

- The Ski Orienteering Committee has three to five members appointed by the Board of Directors from the Orienteering Canada membership. The Board of Directors shall appoint the Chair of the committee.

Scope of Responsibility

The Ski-Orienteering committee is responsible for:

- developing ski-orienteering in Canada
- developing relevant educational materials for ski-orienteering officials and coaches and other relevant guidelines
- developing relevant content for the Orienteering Canada website, its social media platforms, Orienteering Canada newsletter, press releases and general public awareness
- selecting Canadian athletes, coaches and officials to IOF sanctioned competitions (aside from World Ranking events that are open to all)
- recruiting and selecting of hosts for the Canadian Ski-Orienteering Championships
- liaising with other Committees as required
