Terms of Reference  
Standing Committee

### Committee Purpose

The Coaching Program Committee leads and manages the programs of Orienteering Canada that recruit, train and educate coaches.

### Committee Membership

- The Coaching Program Committee has three to eight members appointed by the Board of Directors from the Orienteering Canada membership.

### Scope of Responsibility

The Coaching Program Committee is responsible for:

- management of the National Coaching Certification Program for Orienteering, including:
  - development of the Community and Competitive coaching streams for orienteering
  - liaison with the Coaching Association of Canada
  - liaison with each provincial and territorial member association regarding coaching certification
- development and activation of an implementation plan for coaching programs or projects that increase the number of coaches and will improve and provide consistency for community coaching across the country.
- implementation and management of non-certification coaching education and professional development opportunities offered by Orienteering Canada.
- develop resource materials for coach training and development.
