



MAPPING COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

Committee Purpose

The Mapping Committee leads and manages programs of Orienteering Canada relating to mapping and mappers.

Committee Membership

The Mapping Committee has four to seven members, appointed by the Orienteering Canada Board of Directors, from the Orienteering Canada membership. Representation from many regions of the country is encouraged.

Scope of Responsibility

The Mapping Committee is responsible for:

- Establishing and maintaining a database of orienteering mappers in Canada;
- Establishing training opportunities for mappers in Canada;
- Coordinating the hiring of foreign mappers in Canada, as necessary;
- Ensuring that IOF mapping standards are maintained for orienteering mapping in Canada;
- Exploring the options for a map database/repository and creating and maintaining such system if/as decided upon.
- Acting as Orienteering Canada's liaison with the IOF on mapping-related issues.
- Facilitating communication between mappers, clubs and PTOAs about mapping-related issues.
- Acting as Orienteering Canada's lead on other mapping-related issues.
