### **Committee Purpose**

The Officials Program Committee leads and manages the programs of Orienteering Canada that recruit, train and educate officials.

### **Committee Membership**

- The Officials Program Committee has three to six members appointed by the Board of Directors from the Orienteering Canada membership.

### **Scope of Responsibility**

The Officials Committee is responsible for:

- transitioning the work of the Ad Hoc Officials Program Update Steering Committee to the Officials Program Committee
- activation and implementation of the revised Officials Programs
- the design, development and publication of new officials' manuals
- working with Provincial and Territorial members to ensure delivery of the officials programs across the country
- developing an appropriate database system and maintaining officials' records
