**Terms of Reference
Standing Committee**

Committee Purpose

The Sass Peepre Junior Development Committee leads and manages the programs of Orienteering Canada that exist to teach, train and motivate junior participants in the sport. The committee objectives are:

- to support junior orienteering in Canada;
- to foster leadership skills among junior orienteers;
- to produce competent, life-long orienteers by teaching navigation skills and promoting friendships;
- to benefit the greatest number of junior orienteers possible.
- to give priority to hold at least one national junior training camp in Canada annually. Every effort shall be made to have a national junior training camp in conjunction with each Canadian Championship.

Committee Membership

- The Sass Peepre Junior Development Committee has three to six members appointed by the Board of Directors from the Orienteering Canada membership.

Scope of Responsibility

The Committee is responsible for:

- developing and implementing a national junior curriculum;
- fostering leadership skills among junior orienteers;
- helping to improve junior development programs through strategies including improved information sharing across Orienteering Canada's membership;
- developing programming for young orienteers with potential to join the High Performance Program in future;
- ensuring junior programming is in line with Orienteering Canada's Long Term Athlete Development model;
- liaising with other committees as required;
- delivering the Sass Peepre Junior Training Camp;
- making recommendations to the Orienteering Canada Board for the purpose of administering the Sass Peepre Fund according to the committee's objectives
